

Application Process for Joining Our Karate Club and Association

Application Process

Joining our karate club is a simple process that lets students try training before fully committing. Follow the steps below:

Step 1: Trial Lesson Price £10

Each prospective student is encouraged to participate in a trial lesson. This allows them to experience the training environment and techniques firsthand. The trial lesson is a prerequisite to joining and provides an opportunity to evaluate whether karate and the club are the right fit.

Step 2: Membership Enrolment

After completing the trial lesson, students are required to enrol by paying the following memberships:

- Club Annual Membership Fee: £50 for all students
- Association Annual Membership Fee:
- Juniors (students under 18): £27
- Seniors (students 18 and above): £30

These fees ensure that students are officially part of the club and association, enabling them to participate in courses, events, and tournaments.

Step 3: Monthly Karate Course Fee

Once membership is confirmed, students are required to pay the monthly karate course fee of £48. This fee is paid via standing order each month and covers access to regular training sessions.

Additional Notes

- Membership and course fees are non-refundable.

- Standing orders for the monthly fee must be set up promptly after enrolment.
- The club and association memberships are annual and must be renewed each year.
